DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

2. Judges 21:25 says "In those days Israel had no king; everyone did as they saw fit." How is this description resemble our world today?
3. Read Judges 6:1-12.
 - The people of Israel were scared of the Midianites. What is the real reason behind their trouble? Hint: read v.1 & v.10. What does this tell you about God?
 - What was Gideon doing when the angel of the Lord came to him? Why did he do it in a winepress insted of the open space? v.11. What does this tell you about Gideon?
 - How did the angel of the Lord greet Gideon? v.12. Do you think it's an appropriate greeting considering what we read in v.11?
4. Application:
 - God sees something in Gideon that Gideon hasn't seen in himself because God sees the potential in every person. What does God see in you today that maybe up until now you haven't seen in yourself? Hint: Get your LINK member to help you if you're struggling with this question.
 - How can you see people the way God sees them?
 - Gideon's life changed only after he had a personal encounter with God (v.11-12). What are some practical things you can do to have a consistent a personal encounter with God?
