INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 2. Read Galatians 3:26-29. What happens when you place your faith in Jesus Christ? Does it mean we lose our other identify? What does that mean then?
- 3. Read Hebrews 10:23-25
 - Are you able to recall a time when life threw you some curve balls and someone else's faith and encouragement carried you through?
 - How can this group give you encouragement in your workplace and home life this week?
 What can we celebrate together?
- 4. Read Hebrews 3:13.
 - Who do you need to be a cheerleader for at the moment? How can you applaud who they are and what they mean to you in your life?
 - What would your life look like if you were to commit to a week of encouraging people in their work life? Would you be willing to make that commitment and report back to the group next time you meet?
